In addition to the completed application form, the following information is required:

- Copy of letter of acceptance from college, vocational school, technical school, Blue Water Middle College, or proof of enrollment for the fall semester of the application year.
- An **official** current copy of high school transcript or college transcript if attending college. If an **official** transcript is not available, then an unofficial transcript must be turned in. A signed letter with reason for the unofficial transcript must be accompanied and signed by Principal or counselor
- A letter of recommendation from a current counselor or teacher.
- A letter of recommendation from current or previous horse project leader
- Essay: 300 to 500 words “ *As a horse owner/rider what is your biggest health concern for your horse? As a horse owner/rider do you believe the Coggins (Equine Infectious Anemia) Test is needed and effective for screening (yes or no and why)?* ”
- List of career participation in the county 4-H horse project and activities (such as Winter Achievement, State Awards, Teen Leader, Horseless Horse, clinics, any committee involvement, Animal Mania, Expo Days, Educational Trips, etc.)
- List summary of school/church/community involvement.

The Sue Jones Memorial Scholarship is given to 4-H horse project members planning to enroll in an institution of higher learning, such as a college, vocational, or technical school. The scholarship money is applicable to tuition or book costs.

The following requirements MUST be met:

1. Applicant must have been a 4-H horse project member in St. Clair County for at least three years.
2. All material submitted must be in original form. No faxes, etc.
3. Application Form and requirements must be complete
4. Applicant may apply annually, beginning the age of 16 Jan. 1 and may apply to age of 19 Jan 1 of the current year. Any monies awarded will be deposited into a MESP account

It is up to the Applicant to open the MESP account and supply the account number for deposit. This is required to be completed within 90 day of award.

THE SELECTION COMMITTEE is comprised of Five HORSE PROJECT LEADERS or PARENTS.

All scholarship monies awarded at the discretion of the committee. Applications will be returned to the applicant by request up to 60 days after announcement of awards. Applications scored by the following criteria:

<i>Involvement in 4-H Horse Project</i>	<i>30 points</i>
<i>GPA</i>	<i>10 points</i>
<i>School/Church/Community Involvement</i>	<i>10 points</i>
<i>Other 4-H Participation</i>	<i>15 points</i>
<i>Letters of Recommendation</i>	<i>10 points</i>
<i>Essay</i>	<i>25 points</i>
	<i>100 points</i>

Interviews granted at the discretion of the committee based on scoring. Incomplete applications will not be considered. Letters will be sent to those applicants granted an interview. All applicants are required to confirm their interview appointments by a specified time to be determined. No phone interviews allowed. Every interviewee must make himself or herself available for the interview time to be eligible. Those applicants granted an interview would receive a maximum of 25 points for the interview portion. Winners will be announced at Presentation Parade during fair.
